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#### MUSCLE SPASM

• They are common condition often associated with sports and excessive everyday activities.

# **Clinical Manifestations**

- Pain
- Palpable
- Tense and firm muscle mass
- Diminished ROM, if a joint is involved.

# Diagnostic Evaluation

- History Collection and
- Physical Examination

# Treatment

- Drug Therapy:
  - –Analgesics
  - -NSAIDs and
  - -Skeletal Muscles Relaxant.

# Cont...

- *Physical Therapy*:
  - -Hot or Cold Compress
  - -Supervised Massage
  - Hydrotherapy
  - Ultrasound
  - -Manipulation and
  - -Bracing.

## BURSITIS

 Bursae are closed sacs that are lined with synovial membrane that contain a small amount of synovial fluid.

#### Causes

- Bursitis results from
- Repeated or excessive trauma or friction
- Gout
- Rheumatic Arthritis or Infection

#### **Risk Factors**

- Repetitive Kneeling
- Jogging in worn-out shoes
- Prolonged sitting with crossing legs are common precipitating factors.

### Management

- Rest
- Icing the area
- NSAIDs and
- Inj. Corticosteroids
- Surgery
  - Bursectomy
