Definition

Intestinal infection is one of the leading

- causes of stomach ache in children. Such
- infections in young children are mostly caused
- by intestinal parasites such as worms.
- These worms then live in the intestine and
- feed on your child's nutrition

Types

There are different types of intestinal worms that

an cause worm infections, but the most common

are:

- ✤ Tapeworms,
- ✤Roundworms,
- Pinworms or Threadworms
- ✤ Hookworms.

Causes

- Contact with an infected surface such as soil containing eggs or germs at a playground or touching pets infected with worms
- Consuming infected food or water
- Improper hygiene
- Inadequate hand washing

Sign & Symptoms

Some common symptoms of worm infections are

□ Irritability,

- Uveight loss,
- □ Stomach ache,
- □ Bed wetting,
- Blood in stools.

Besides these, each worm infection has symptoms as listed below:

- Tapeworm infection Jaundice, nausea, vomiting, loss of appetite, eating too frequently and sometimes even malnutrition
- *Roundworm infection* Diarrhea, passing worms with stools, dry cough, fever
- Pinworm infection Itching around the anus, trouble sleeping due to itching, painful urination
- Hookworm infection Wheezing, coughing, fatigue, anemia,

Diagnostic evaluation

- History collection
- Physical management
- Warm identification
- Assess sign and symptoms

Treatment

Most worm infections can be easily treated.
Your doctor will

prescribe a course of

- Anti-parasitic medicines.
- Anti-worm
- Deworming medicines are also available.
- Good hygiene practices along with medication for quicker and effective recovery.
