# BULIMIA NERVOSA

## Definition

Bulimia nervous is a disorder of binge eating, where the individual consume large amount of food with the lack of control followed by various compansatory behavior (like self induse vomiting) to control weight

# Etiology

• Society's emphasis on appearence and thinness

Family disturbance or conflict

Sexual abuse

### Incidence

- Incidence of bulimia nervosa is higher than anorexia nervosa
- the disorder is seen in age group of 15 to 30 year ,with peak incidence at about 18 to 19 year of age.

### Clinical features

- Increase dental caries
- Amenorrhea
- Abdominal and epigastric pain
- Fluid and electrolyte imbalance
- Feeling of Alienation
- Low tolerance for frustration

# Diagnosis

- Medical
- Physical examination
- Complete blood count
- ECG

# Management

### Medical management

- Behaviour modification is used to control binge eating and then inducing vomiting
- Cognitive therapy
- TCAs and SSRIs drugs
- Dietary counselling is healpful

# Nursing intervention

- Engage patient in therapeutic alliance to obtained commitment to treatment
- Set a time limit for each meal
- Identify patients elimination pattern
- encourage patient to recognise and verbalize her feeling about her eating behaviour
- Explain risk of laxative, emetic and diuretic abuse
