ECOPRESIS

Definition

Ecopresis also known as paradoxical diarrhoea is involuntary fecal soiling in children who are past the age of toilet training

Etiology

Stress

• Environmental changes

Income potential of the inner spchincter

•Genetic predisposition

Involuntary control of bladder

Clinical features

Dilation of lower bowel Loose stool, diarrhoea Offensive body order Management

- Empathy of colon of stool
- Promote regular bowel habits
- Behaviour therapy for modification of child 's behaviour
- •Administer enema if needed
- Developing regular toilet habits

Nursing management

- Advised to take proper diet
- •Reinforce proper toilet training habits
- •Behaviour modification techniques must be used
- Use laxatives and stool softness in case of constipation
