Social Security Labor Legislations:

- Labor legislations ensuring Social security were also enacted.
- This intend to provide to the workmen social security benefits under certain contingencies of life and work.

Some of them are:

- The Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923
- The Employee State Insurance Act, 1948
- The Coal Mines PF Act, 1948
- Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952
- Maternity Benefit Act, 1961
- The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972

Welfare Labour Legislations

- The aim of this Legislation is to promoting the general welfare of the workers and improve their living conditions.
- Limestone and Dolomite Mines Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1972.
- The Mica Mines Welfare Fund Act, 1946
- The Iron Ore Mines, Manganese Ore Mines and Chrome Ore Mines Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1976
- The Cine Workers Welfare Fund Act, 1981.
- In addition, some state governments have also enacted legislations for welfare funds.
- Beedi Workers Welfare Fund Act, 1976
