# **INTRODUCTION TO TRANSPORTATION:**

- >Transportation Engineering: is concerned with the application of scientific principles to the planning, design; operation & management of transportation systems.
- Transportation engineering or Transport engineering is the use of innovation and scientific principles to the planning, functional design, operation and management of facilities for any mode of transportation in order to provide for the safe, efficient, rapid, comfortable, convenient, economical, and environmentally compatible movement of people and goods transport.
- ➤ Transportation satisfies these essential needs of humankind. Transportation assumes a significant job in the advancement of the human progress.
- There is a strong correlation between the quality of transport facilities and standard of living, because of which society places a great expectation from transportatio facilities.
- The solution to transportation problems must be analytically based, economically sound, socially credible, environmentally sensitive, practically acceptable and sustainable. Alternatively, the transportation solution should be safe, rapid, comfortable, convenient, economical, and eco-friendly for both men andmaterial.
- ➤ Road transport is one of the most common mode of transport. Roads in the form of track ways, human pathways etc. were used even from the pre-historic times.

The term is gotten from the Latin tran ("over") and portare ("to convey"). Transportation is a science that concerns with the efficient movement of people and goods that is undertaken to accomplish objectives to complete tasks that require transfer from one location to another

#### **Modes of Transportation:**

#### **SOCIAL ROLE OF TRANSPORTATION:**
