## LECTURE 16: PATENT LAW: GRANT OF PATENT AND OPPOSITION

#### **Grounds of oppositions for grant of Patents:-**

The grounds of opposition for grant of patents are as follows:-

- Wrongfully obtained the complete inventions.
- Prior publication of specification in India or elsewhere.
- Invention is subject matter of prior claim.
- The invention claimed by applicant does not include any inventive step.
- The invention is not Patentable or its Patenting is prohibited by Law.
- The complete specification of the application does not sufficiently describe the invention or method by which it is to be used.
- In case of foreign application fail to relating to such application to be filed in foreign country.

#### **❖** Grant of Patent:-

- 1. The application which has not been refused by the controller.
- 2. The application which has not been found in contravention of any of the provisions of the Act
