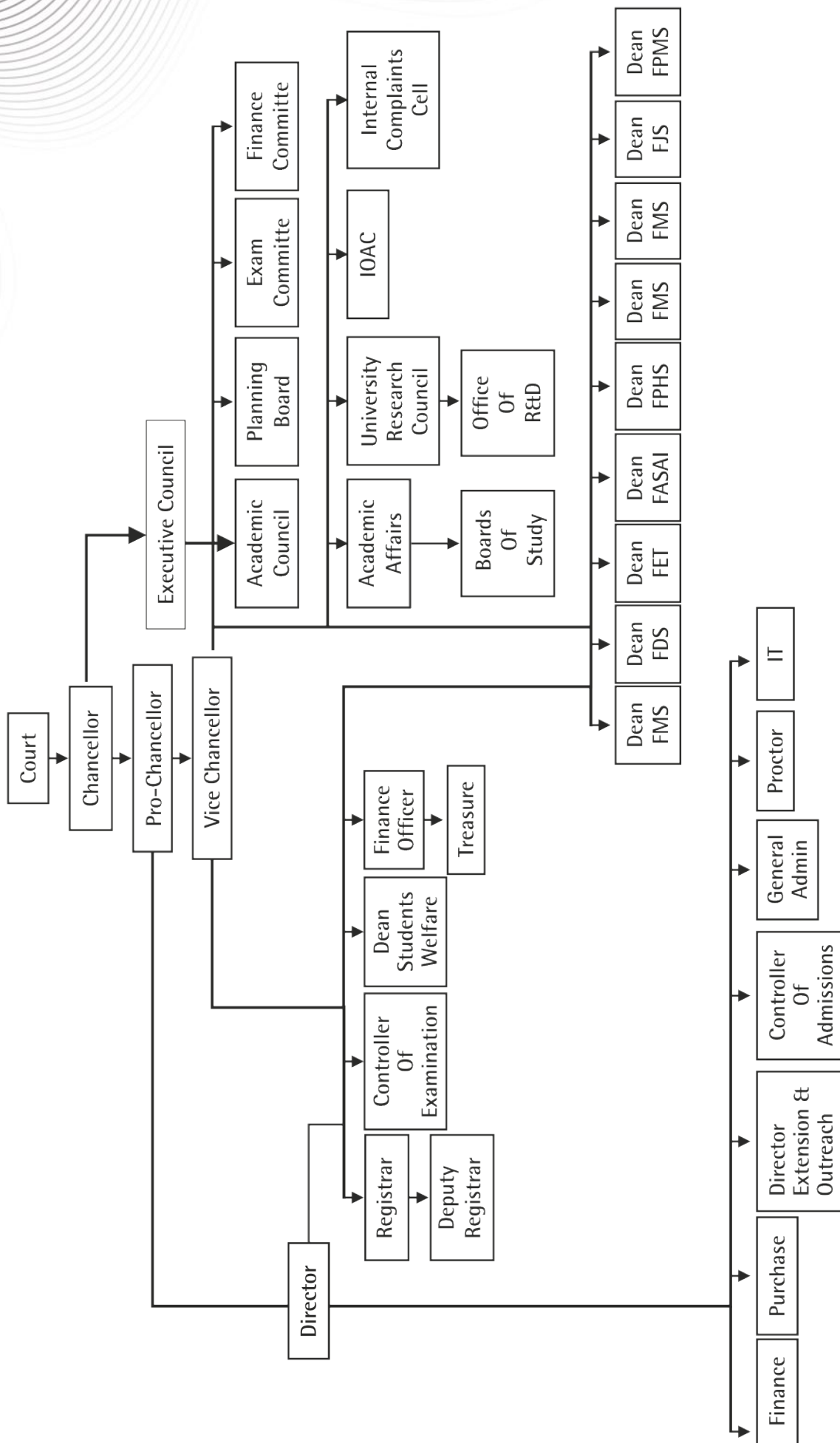

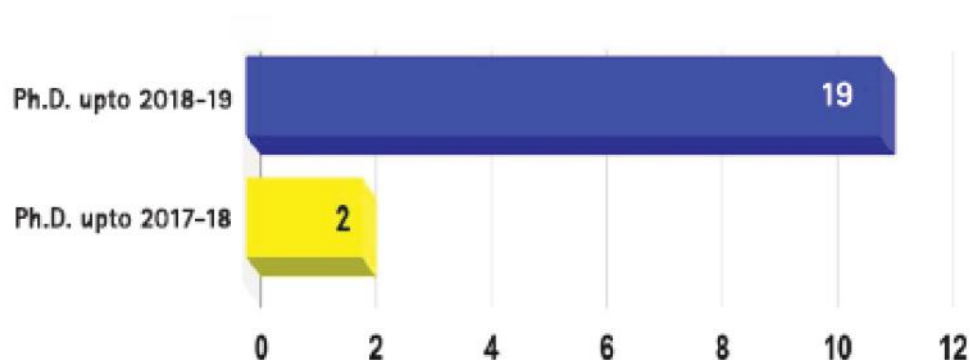
Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.)

Examination

The University Examination system is divided in to two parts :-

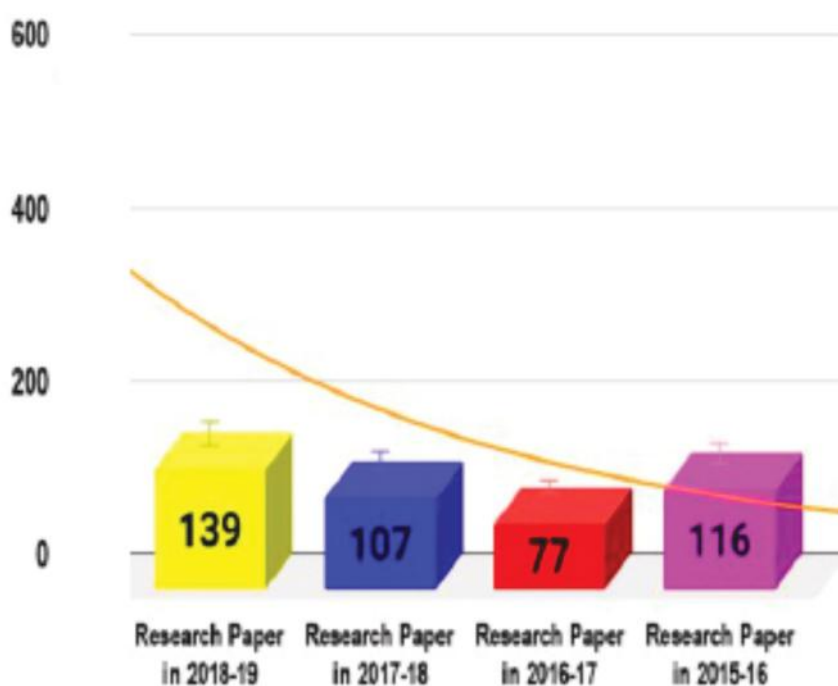
