1. to prepare and recommend short-term and long-term plans of the University;
2. to conduct periodic impact assessment of the educational programmes offered by the University (Faculties & Department);
3. to frame structures, rules, norms and processes to facilitate smooth functioning and quality enhancement;
4. to identify and recommend to the Governing Body/Executive Council/Academic Council on new areas of study keeping in view the vision and mission of the University;
5. to develop financial models and recommend ideas for resource mobilization, funding initiatives and fund management to the Sponsoring Body as well as Governing Body;
6. to recommend the principles and policy framework for financial and Human Resource planning and norms for allocation for various activities of the University;
7. to plan and review the infrastructure development of the University;
8. to plan and recommend the design framework of comprehensive information system covering all aspects of the functioning of the University;
9. any other work that the Planning and Advisory Board can take for itself, or which other statutory bodies assign the Planning Board.
