MINUTES OF MEETING

The Quarterly Meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was held on 29th December 2025 at the VC Conference Hall under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Rama University Uttar Pradesh, Kanpur.

Minutes of the Meeting

Agenda 1: Review of Activities Conducted During August – December 2025

The Dean IQAC presented the summary of various academic, faculty development, extension, research, and student welfare activities conducted by different faculties and departments during the period from August to December 2025.

Members appreciated the successful organization of:

- Faculty Development Programmes

- Workshops and Seminars
- Expert Lectures
- Student Skill Development Activities
- Community Outreach Programmes
- Health Awareness Campaigns
- Extension Activities
- Research and Innovation Programmes

The committee appreciated the active participation of faculty members and students in all institutional activities conducted during the semester.

The IQAC emphasized maintaining proper documentation including attendance sheets, reports, photographs, feedback forms, certificates, and activity outcomes for NAAC evidence and institutional record maintenance.

Agenda 2: Review of the activities during august to December-2025

The committee reviewed various faculty enrichment programmes conducted during the semester including:

1. **Faculty Development Programme on “Transforming Agriculture through Technological Interventions”** (5 August 2025) – Dean FASAI informed that the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences and Allied Industries organized a Faculty Development Programme focusing on innovative agricultural technologies and sustainable development practices. The IQAC appreciated the initiative for promoting interdisciplinary learning and technological advancement in agriculture.
2. **Hybrid Faculty Development Programme on “Fueling research innovation to elevate academic and industrial Health outcomes”** by Faculty of Nursing (26th to 30th August- 2025) – Dean Nursing apprised that the Faculty of Nursing conducted a Hybrid Faculty Development Programme with active participation from faculty members and healthcare professionals. The committee appreciated the efforts in strengthening academic excellence and professional competency among nursing educators.
3. **Extension and Community Outreach Activities Conducted** by Various Departments (August–December 2025) – Members informed the committee regarding various extension programmes including health awareness campaigns, community outreach initiatives, plantation drives, social responsibility programmes, educational awareness activities, cleanliness drives, and student engagement programmes

organized across departments. The IQAC appreciated the contribution towards community welfare, social awareness, and institutional social responsibility.

4. **Health Awareness and Community Welfare Programmes** – Departments conducted several awareness programmes related to health, hygiene, preventive care, nutrition, environmental sustainability, and social wellbeing. The committee appreciated the active participation of students and faculty members in community-oriented services.
5. **Plantation Drives and Environmental Awareness Activities** – Various departments organized plantation drives and environmental awareness initiatives within and outside the campus to promote environmental sustainability and social responsibility. The IQAC recommended maintaining detailed reports and photographic evidence for institutional documentation.
6. **Continuing Nursing Education Programme on “Heartelligence in Nursing”** (17 October 2025) – Dean Nursing informed that a Continuing Nursing Education Programme titled “Heartelligence in Nursing” was organized to enhance professional knowledge and clinical competency among nursing professionals. The committee appreciated the initiative for promoting quality nursing education and healthcare practices.
7. **National Conference on Constitutional Day** (3 December 2025) – Dean Faculty of Juridical Sciences informed that a National Conference was organized on the occasion of Constitutional Day focusing on constitutional values, legal awareness, and contemporary legal issues. The committee appreciated the initiative for promoting academic discourse and legal education.
8. **International Conference on “Global Nurses United Voices”** (11–13 December 2025) – Dean Nursing informed that the Faculty of Nursing successfully organized an International Conference on the theme “Global Nurses United Voices” from 11th to 13th December 2025 with participation from academicians, healthcare professionals, researchers, nursing faculty members, and students from various institutions. The conference focused on strengthening global nursing perspectives, innovative healthcare practices, research collaboration, and professional development in nursing education and practice. The IQAC appreciated the Faculty of Nursing for successfully organizing the international conference and advised proper maintenance of conference

proceedings, reports, photographs, participant records, and feedback documentation for institutional and NAAC evidence.

The IQAC committee appreciated all faculties and departments for actively conducting faculty enrichment programmes, extension activities, conferences, workshops, awareness programmes, outreach initiatives, and student-centered activities during the period from August to December 2025. Members emphasized maintaining proper reports, attendance records, feedback forms, photographs, and outcome-based documentation for institutional quality assurance and NAAC evidence.

Agenda 3: NAAC Quality Initiatives and Documentation

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor instructed all faculties and departments to continue strengthening quality assurance mechanisms and sustain the standards achieved after receiving NAAC 'A' Grade Accreditation.

The members discussed:

It was resolved that all departments shall submit quarterly reports to IQAC regularly.

Agenda 4: Research and Academic Collaborations

Members discussed the need for improving:

- Research publications in indexed journals
- Faculty participation in conferences and workshops
- Interdisciplinary research collaborations
- Consultancy and innovation activities
- Academic MoU's and institutional collaborations

Faculty members were encouraged to undertake funded research projects and publish quality research papers in reputed journals.

Agenda 5: Student Support and Institutional Best Practices

The committee reviewed various student support initiatives including:

- Mentoring and Counselling Activities
- Placement Guidance Programmes
- Career Development Sessions
- Skill Enhancement Activities
- Student Welfare Initiatives

Departments were instructed to continue implementing student-centered best practices and strengthen experiential learning approaches.

Agenda 6: Employee Appreciation and Best Performer Awards

Following the successful achievement of NAAC 'A' Grade Accreditation, the University organized an Appreciation Ceremony in December 2025 to recognize and honour the dedicated efforts of faculty members, administrative staff, and employees who contributed significantly towards NAAC preparation and institutional quality enhancement.

During the ceremony:

- Certificates of Appreciation were distributed to employees involved in NAAC activities
- Best Performer Awards were presented to outstanding faculty and staff members
- Best Employee Awards were given in recognition of dedication, discipline, sincerity, and quality contribution to the University

The IQAC acknowledged that such initiatives motivate employees and strengthen teamwork, institutional commitment, and a culture of excellence.


Agenda 7: Infrastructure and Quality Enhancement
