Agenda 1: Review of Academic, Extension and Outreach Activities

The Dean IQAC presented the summary of activities conducted by various faculties and departments during January–March 2026.

1. **National Farmers Day (08 January 2026)** – Faculty of Agricultural Sciences and Allied Industries organized National Farmers Day to recognize the contribution of farmers towards agricultural development and food security. The programme included awareness sessions on modern agricultural practices, sustainable farming, and technological advancements in agriculture. The committee appreciated the initiative for promoting agricultural awareness and farmer welfare.

2. **Educational Visit to Sparkle Child Therapy Centre (25 February 2026)** – Faculty of Nursing organized an educational visit to Sparkle Child Therapy Centre to provide students

with practical exposure to multidisciplinary child healthcare services and rehabilitation practices. The committee appreciated the initiative and advised proper documentation of the activity.

3. Vaccination Drive (16 March 2026) – The NSS Unit of Rama University organized a Vaccination Drive to promote preventive healthcare awareness and community well-being. The IQAC appreciated the social responsibility initiative and active participation of students and faculty members.

4. School Adoption Programme (20 March 2026) – The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, conducted a School Adoption Programme focusing on oral health awareness, preventive dental care, and health education among school children. The committee appreciated the outreach activity and advised continuation of such community-based programmes.

5. Community Outreach and Awareness Activities – Various faculties and departments conducted awareness programmes, student welfare activities, outreach initiatives, and community engagement programmes during the review period. The committee appreciated the efforts made towards social responsibility, community service, and student engagement

The IQAC appreciated all departments for actively conducting extension and outreach activities during January–March 2026 and advised maintaining proper reports, attendance records, photographs, feedback forms, and outcome-based documentation for institutional quality assurance and future reference.

Agenda 2: Review of NAAC Post-Accreditation Quality Initiatives

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor congratulated all faculty members, administrative staff, and supporting staff for their continuous contribution towards maintaining the standards achieved after securing NAAC 'A' Grade Accreditation.

The following points were discussed:

1. All departments shall continue maintaining criterion-wise documentation and evidence files.
2. Quality enhancement initiatives undertaken after NAAC accreditation shall be regularly monitored.
3. Departmental best practices and innovative initiatives shall be documented and shared through IQAC.
4. Continuous academic and administrative audits shall be conducted for quality improvement.

Agenda 3: AQAR Preparation and Documentation

The committee reviewed the status of AQAR preparation and discussed the following:

1. All Deans, Principals, and Heads of Departments shall complete and submit AQAR-related data within the stipulated timeline.

2. Department-wise criterion files shall be updated regularly.
3. Activity reports, attendance records, photographs, feedback forms, and outcome reports shall be maintained properly.
4. Website data and departmental achievements shall be updated periodically.

The committee emphasized timely submission of documents to IQAC for consolidation and record maintenance.

Agenda 4: Review of Infrastructure and Administrative Requirements

The committee reviewed the infrastructural and administrative requirements across faculties and departments.

It was resolved that:

1. All departments shall submit pending infrastructure requirements to the administration.
2. Maintenance of classrooms, laboratories, ICT facilities, and campus infrastructure shall be carried out on priority.
3. Library resources and departmental requirements shall be reviewed periodically.
4. Administrative committees and SOPs shall be updated as per institutional requirements.
5. Digital documentation and record management systems shall be strengthened.

Agenda 5: Research, Extension and Quality Enhancement Initiatives

The members discussed strategies to strengthen research and extension activities.

It was resolved that:

1. Departments shall submit proposals for extension and outreach activities regularly.
2. Faculty members shall be encouraged to participate in research projects, conferences, FDPs, and workshops.
3. Research publications in indexed journals shall be promoted.
4. Departments shall strengthen collaborations, MoUs, and community engagement initiatives.
5. Conference proposals and departmental academic plans shall be submitted in advance for effective planning.

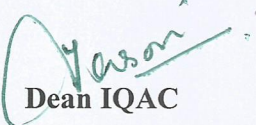
Agenda 6: Future Action Plan for Institutional Development
