



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

RAMA UNIVERSITY, MANDHANA, KANPUR, U.P. and

DEUTSCHE GESELLSCHAFT FÜR HOMA-THERAPIE, GERMANY (DGHT)

(GERMAN ASSOCIATION OF HOMA THERAPY)

RAMA UNIVERSITY (RU)

Rama University is a State Private University running Faculties of Medical Sciences/Para Medical Sciences/ Nursing/ Dental Sciences/ Engineering & Technology/ Commerce & Management/ Professional Studies/ Juridical Sciences/ Agricultural Sciences and Allied Industries/ Ayurveda/ Pharmaceutical Sciences/ Paramedical Sciences was established under Uttar Pradesh Act No. 1 of 201, as passed by the State Legislature, and is empowered to award degrees as specified by University Grant Commission under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 located at Mandhana, Kanpur Nagar, Uttar Pradesh which expression shall include authorized representative of first party (herein after referred to as 'RU' represented by its authorized representative).

GERMAN ASSOCIATION OF HOMA THERAPY (DGHT)

The DGHT - "Deutsche Gesellschaft für Homa-Therapie" (German Association of Homa Therapy), has been established in the year 1988 in Germany. Background was the insight that environmental pollution will be a major challenge for all mankind in the coming decades, and as these problems were expected to be enormous it was seen as necessary to also look into Traditional Knowledge as that of the Vedas for possible solutions.

In order to make such knowledge acceptable to people in our times it was seen as necessary to examine and validate statements about the beneficial effects of Agnihotra and Homa Therapy in terms of modern science.

With this aim in mind the DGHT was established, and is registered at the court Amtsgericht Freiburg (Southern Germany), registration no. VR 590308.

Since then it is the leading organization worldwide concentrating initiating and coordinating research on Agnihotra and Homa Therapy.

1. Purpose of MoU

Rama University (RU) and German Association of Homa Therapy (DGHT) after due discussion have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding in order to explore and promote studies on 'Agnihotra' the ancient Vedic science of healing. This agreement permits the opportunity to pursue research on the basis and applications of wide range of applications of 'Agnihotra' and to conduct training workshops/education programs in India and outside India.

2. Collaboration:

RU and DGHT have mutually agreed to collaborate with each other in the following areas:

Identifying areas of environmental hazards – especially those which affect plant growth, agriculture and horticulture - and examining whether methods of Homa Organic Farming can help to mitigate these hazards.

Systematic studies of the effect of Agnihotra and Homa Therapy on our Environment (atmosphere, soil, water resources, and food).

Teaching, Research and Training in selected and advanced thrust areas of Science and Technology, with special reference to Environmental and Agriculture Sciences;

Science and Technology Transfer wherever it is possible and necessary;

Publication of the results of the research in national and international scientific journals as well as dissemination of these results to a wider audience via newspapers, TV, books, internet, mobiles, and other media.

Any other areas of mutual interest.

DGHT having the necessary expertise and wide experience in Homa Therapy, has agreed to enter into a collaborative understanding with the RU on the terms and conditions mentioned in this MoU.

The above activities are indicative of the collaboration and should not necessarily include or be restricted to those detailed above. Before any of these activities are agreed and implemented both parties shall negotiate the details and resolve and specific issue therewith and enter into an agreement pertaining to that activity (Program specific agreements) if required so.

3. Funding

The parties agree that each activity undertaken pursuant to this MoU shall be dependent on the availability of funds and financial arrangements shall be negotiated prior to entering in to a program specific agreement related to thereafter. The parties agree that they shall use reasonable efforts to find adequate financial resources for the activities undertaken pursuant to this MoU.

4. Terms

This MoU shall become effective upon executions by both parties and shall continue for a period of 5 years unless terminated by either party by giving written notice at least 90 days in advance of the stated termination date, provided however, that the termination of this MoU shall not affect activities already in progress pursuant to the program specific agreement, which should continue until concluded by the parties in accordance with the program specific agreement or otherwise agreed to by the parties in writing.
