DENTAL OPD

Department is situated in the Dental wing of the premises, it has fully functional clinical block and radiology section. The dental OPD has separate undergraduate and postgraduate sections, where in the students examine the patients with the expertise of the faculty members. In OPD there is provision of intraoral camera and computer display which maintains transparency of diagnosis and treatment for the patient. Proper aseptic environment is created in the department with following proper steps in sterilization procedures and all necessary steps are being taken to prevent any cross infection. The tobacco cessation center forms the vital part of the department which is recognized not only provides basic counseling to the patients but also emphasizes on patient's counseling on tobacco and smoking cessation. The patients here are guided for various dental treatment and its outcome, but also for clarifying the myths regarding dental practice.

DENTAL RADIOLOGY DEPARTMENT:

Oral & Maxillofacial Radiology is the specialty of dentistry and discipline of radiology concerned with the production and interpretation of images and data produced by all modalities of radiant energy that are used for the diagnosis and management of diseases, disorders and conditions of the oral and maxillofacial region. Radiology section is equipped with latest equipments, provides radio diagnosis for all the patients and thus helps out clinicians with effective treatment planning of their patients. It offers proper infrastructure and equipments of radiology teaching to under/postgraduate dental students
