## PROGRAM SPECIFIC OUTCOME:

- <u>PSO1:</u> As a oral pathologist the practitioners can be able to diagnose the diseases and help the surgeons in proper treatment and play a major role in management of patients with major medical and dental needs in a hospital settings.
- <u>PSO2:</u> Besides managing patients in final diagnosis of diseases these practitioners are skilled in recognizing diseases both benign to lifethreatening diseases including carcinoma of oral and maxillofacial regions.
- <u>PSO3:</u> To educate the under/postgraduate students to apply fundamental knowledge of oral and maxillofacial pathology to solve various orofacial diseases in their clinical practice.
- <u>PSO4:</u> To develop dental students in such a manner that they shall have the ability to work in groups or individually to develop written and oral presentations skills for effective communication of dental concepts. Students are expected to engage in independent and lifelong learning in the context of Oral and Maxillofacial pathology advancements.
