PROGRAM SPECIFIC OUTCOMES

PSO1: As a command resource, public health practitioners can smooth patient flow with consultation, and provide expertise in the field of preventive dentistry.

PSO2: To inculcate the ability in the under/postgraduates dental students to apply fundamental knowledge of Public Health Dentistry to identify various dental diseases in their clinical practice and provide relevant treatment to the patients.

PSO3: To develop dental students in such a manner that they shall have the ability to work in groups or individually to develop written and oral presentations skills for effective communication of dental concepts. Students are expected to engage in independent and lifelong learning in the context of Public Health Dentistry advancements.

PSO4: Dental ethics and its implementation during dental treatment is the most important skill that is developed in the dental students.
